Rules

This Competition will be held under UIM Rules with the exception of the following special conditions: -

Special conditions applied to this event

Boat on Boat Contact

The UK operates a non-contact policy where any contact (no matter how small) between boats will result in a DQ. You may however continue racing if safe to do so. If applicable a no cost reduced protest procedure may be made. For details of this please contact race control.

Overtaking

- a) Any overtaking boat must give way to the overtaken boat.
- b) A boat being overtaken must not deliberately alter its course in any way that would hinder the overtaking boat.
- c) An overtaking boat must in all circumstances be prepared to alter its course to avoid a collision.
- d) During Multi-Class races, boats on the longer course may only pass outside of the boats on the shorter course.
- e) Extra caution is advisable when overtaking canopied boats that may have limited all-round visibility, especially to the rear.
- f) If a boat in consequence of its neglect of any of these rules compels another to foul, it will be disqualified.
- g) Definition of fouling - if any boat by its action causes another boat to have a collision or causes another boat to take action to avoid a collision which may or may not result in that boat infringing another rule. (e.g. missing or hitting a mark of the course), they will be penalised.

Entry fee

There is no entry fee applicable to overseas competitors. There is however a Financial Guarantee of £200 refundable upon crossing the start line in one of the races. Entry Forms will be sent upon request.

Prizes

There will be Trophies awarded to top three Drivers & Co-Drivers in each class over the whole event.

Minimum Age

UIM Rule 702.1

For Classes 3: 3J the minimum age is 13 years, 3A and 3B, the minimum age is 16 years. For Classes 3C and above, the pilot must also have raced in at least three races in a powerboat class with minimum 90 hp. Those under 18 years may participate as Co-Driver / Navigator only by providing parental consent specific to this championship, in writing.

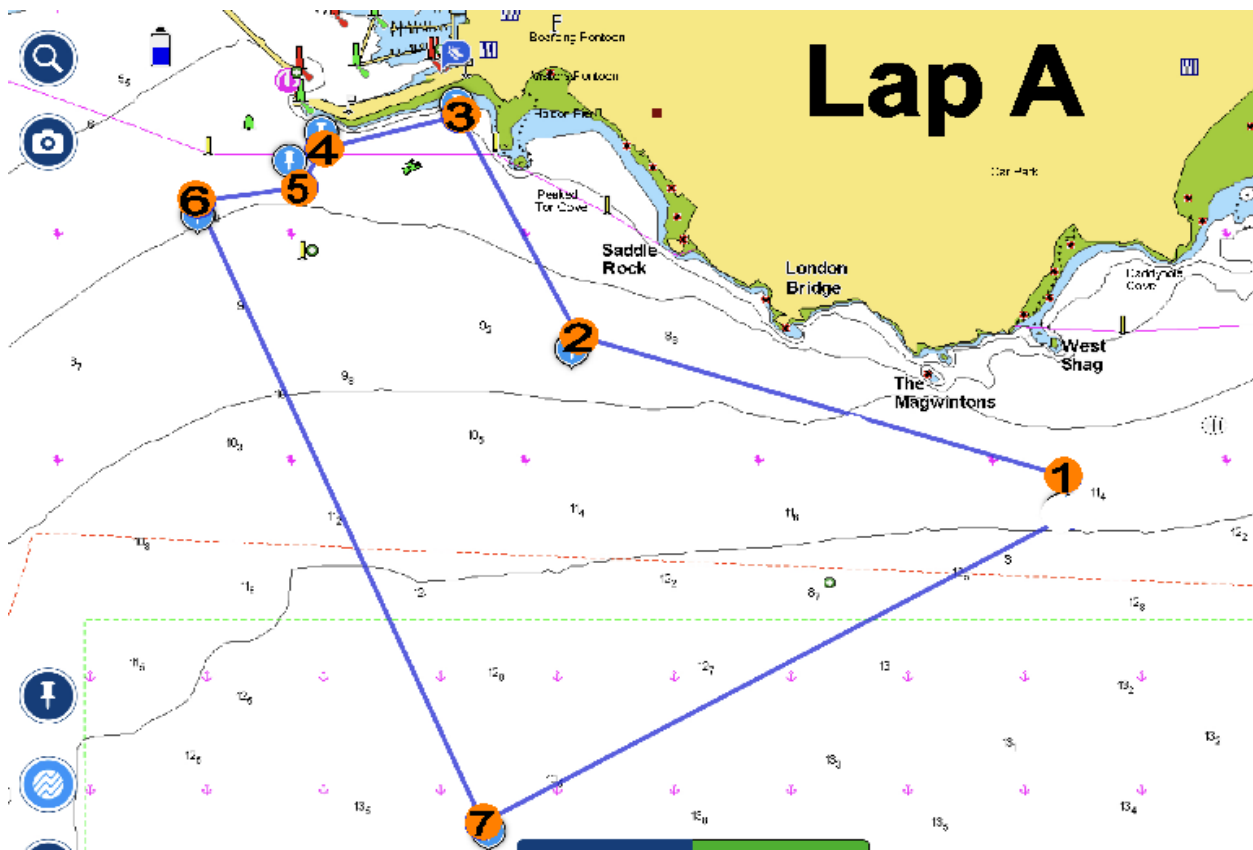

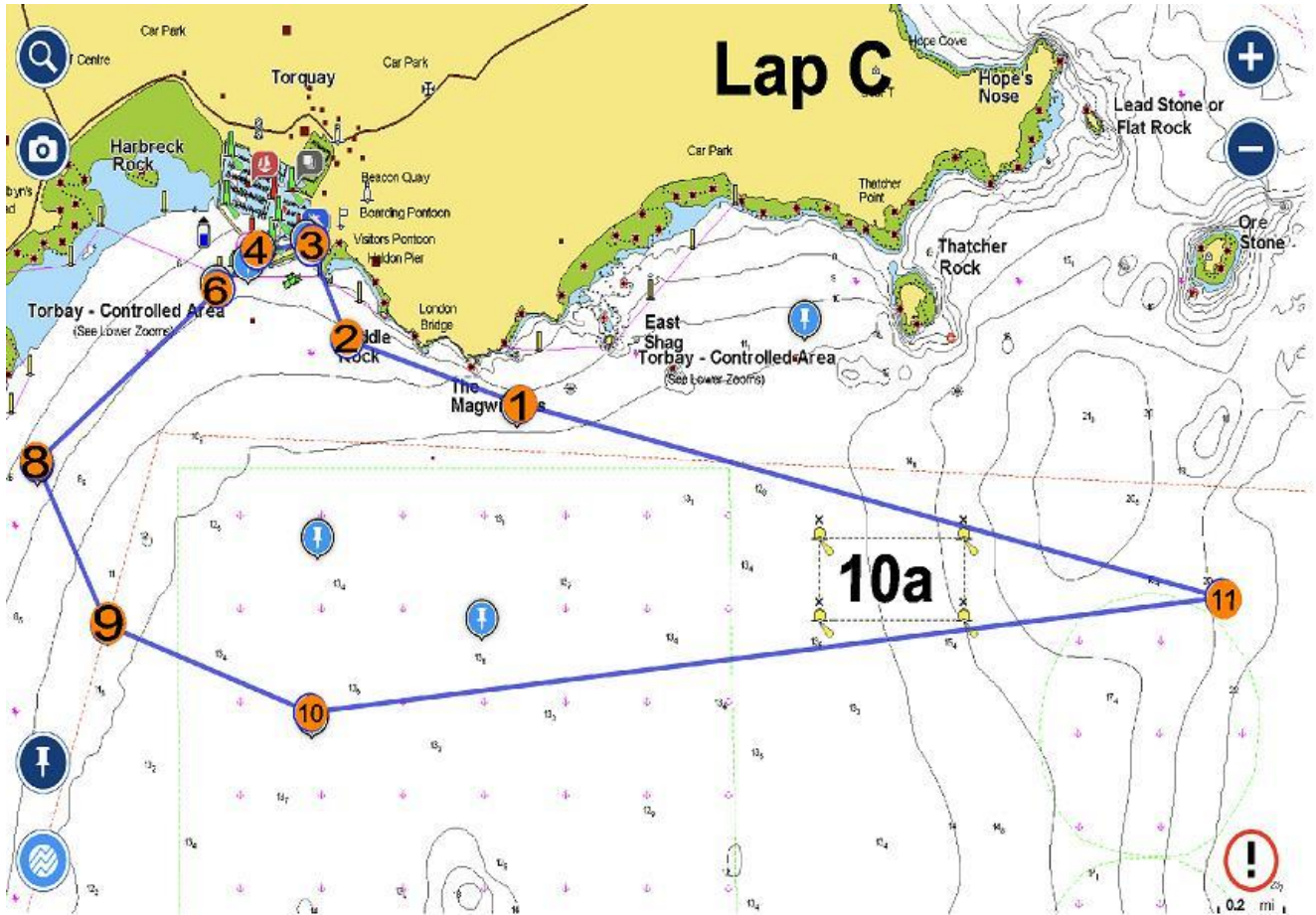
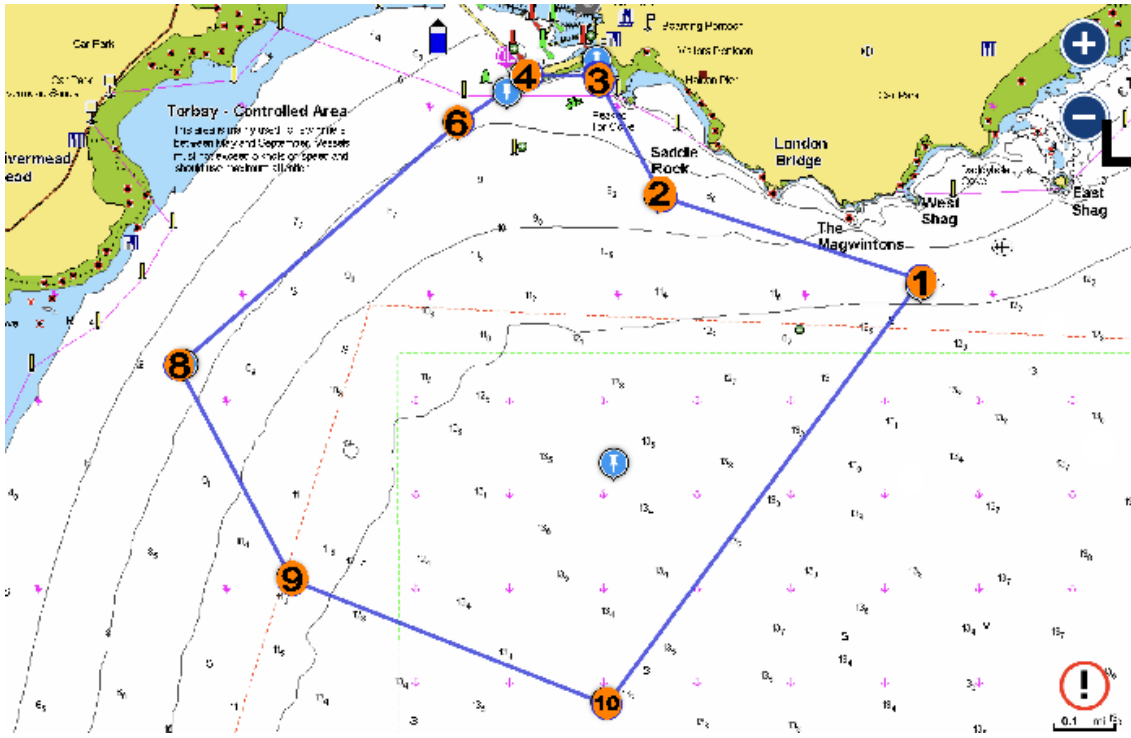
